Just a reminder that students first day back is Tuesday, October 15th!

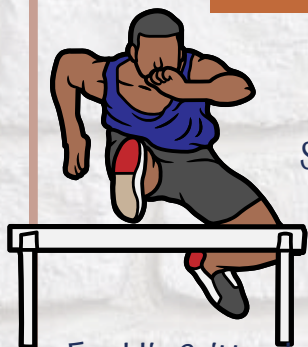
