

Policy JICK: BULLYING / HARASSMENT / INTIMIDATION

Student Rights and Services

When a bullying, harassment, intimidation report is submitted, and in accordance with Arizona Revised Statute (AS) 153-341.36, the following rights, protections and services are available:

- The *Handbook for Student Success* contains information to report and seek resolution related to the bullying report.
- Arizona Revised Statute 153-341.36 provides guidance to Arizona schools related to reporting and resolving bullying incidents.

Protections

Additional information on the items listed below is available from the school principal or discipline team:

- Threat Assessment in accordance with District procedures
- Potential disciplinary consequences for offenders
- Health Center referrals, when necessary
- Individual Safety Plans
- Other protections on a case-by-case basis

Services

Additional information on the items listed below is available from the school principal or discipline team:

- Prevention counseling services
- Small group counseling sessions
- Intervention strategies
- Peer Mediation
- Other services according to individual circumstances

NOTE: The provisions of the information in this document do not constitute confirmation of the bullying report. A thorough investigation must first be conducted including affording due process to the alleged offender. At the conclusion of the investigation, you will be provided notification of the closure of the bullying report
